#### 5.3 <u>CEO Update</u> – K. Su

K. Su reported that on Tuesday, March 16, 2021, the federal government announced it had reversed its order for funding cuts to accessible books production for this year.

A cease and desist order was sent to libraries from Blue Ice Pots with claims regarding several titles that vendors have not purchased proper rights. In response, SCPL has pulled 25 titles from the shelves until an investigation is completed.

## 5.4 <u>Department Updates – R. Di Marcantonio</u>

R. Di Marcantonio updated the Board about some non-traditional collections that have been implemented in the past few weeks:

- Wireless hotspots (10) have been distributed to 2 Niagara Area Seniors Centres to allow resident's access to unlimited data Wi-Fi,
- Wireless hotspots (5) have been purchased for circulation to patrons,
- Ontario Parks Passes (12) allow vehicle day access to any provincial park,
- Niagara Peninsula Conservation Authority NaturePlus Passes (4) allow day access to local conservation areas.

R. Di Marcantonio also outlined a library promotional opportunity through CKTB Radio that began with some trial segments in January and February of Saturday morning conversations on the Matt Holmes Show. The station has since invited the Library to continue the Saturday morning partnership with 5 minute presentations every 2 weeks by staff members on various current topics.
